AN ORDINANCE TO ADD NEW SECTION 8.24.060 PROHIBITING SCAVENGING FROM SOLID WASTE RECEPTACLES WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FIG GARDEN POLICE PROTECTION DISTRICT, TO CHAPTER 24, WASTE DISPOSAL, OF THE ORDINANCE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds there is a continuing problem of persons
scavenging from solid waste receptacles. Scavenging can result in injuries to the scavengers,
waste being strewn about the surrounding areas, containers being left open to emit foul odors
and attract animals and pests, theft of recyclable material, and identify theft.

Prohibiting the scavenging from solid waste containers benefits the health, safety, and
welfare of the public by protecting persons from illness and injury, reducing blight and
nuisances, and preventing crime.

On September 27, 2016, the Board of Supervisors enacted an ordinance adding
Section 8.24.060 to the Ordinance Code of the County of Fresno, which prohibited
scavenging from solid waste receptacles within the Fig Garden Policing District Boundaries,
for a one year period. That ordinance will expire on or about October 27, 2017.

The Board of Supervisors finds that the Ordinance has been successful in that it made scavenging more difficult and provides enforcement personnel with tools needed to issue citations where appropriate. The Board of Supervisors finds that the reenactment of the of the

provisions of the Ordinance for an additional year will allow law enforcement more time to 2 assess the effectiveness of the program and the staffing demands for potential implementation in other unincorporated areas of Fresno County. 3

Section 2: Section 8.24.060 is hereby added to Chapter 8.24 Waste Disposal, of Title 8 of the Ordinance Code of the County of Fresno, to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 8.24.060 Scavenging Prohibited

Α. No person shall open, look into, search through or remove any of the contents of any solid waste receptacle.

Β. For purposes of this section, "solid waste receptacle" shall mean any bin, automatic lift container or any other type of receptacle used for the deposit, storage, collection or transport of garbage, litter, junk, debris, refuse, swill, rubbish, waste matter, putrescible waste, hazardous waste, infectious waste, recyclable materials, or garden refuse.

C. This section shall not apply to the following persons:

1. Any owner, tenant, lessee, or occupant of the property for which the solid waste receptacle is used;

2. Any persons acting with the consent of any owner, tenant, lessee, or occupant of the property for which the solid waste receptacle is used;

3. Any private collector or any contractor of a private collector, that owns or maintains the solid waste receptacle or is responsible for hauling away its contents, who is acting in accordance with their duties as such; or

4. Any employee or contactor of any city, county, state or federal government agency, who is acting in accordance with their duties as such.

20 D. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, any person violating this section is guilty of an infraction. The first violation of this section in any 12 month period shall 21 22 be punished by a fine of \$100. The second violation of this section in the same 12 month 23 period shall be punished by a fine of \$200. The third and each subsequent violation of this

1	section within the same 12 month period shall be punished by a fine of \$300 for each
2	violation.
3	E. This section shall apply and be enforced only in the following area of the
4	unincorporated County of Fresno: Fig Garden Policing District Boundaries.
5	Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days from its adoption and shall
6	continue in force for a period of one year from the effective date at which time, unless
7	amended or extended by the Board of Supervisors, this Ordinance shall be repealed without
8	further action of the Board of Supervisors.
