Hamilton Avenue in the City of Fresno; and 11 WHEREAS, on August 14, 2017, staff discovered that a water leak had developed in the 12 Elections Warehouse over the weekend. In which a plastic water feeder line in a swamp cooler had 13 deteriorated and failed, causing water to spill onto storage shelves and spread across multiple isles, 14 which resulted in the saturation of approximately 200 boxes containing Elections material; and 15 WHEREAS, there were present an immediate need for preservation of public health, welfare, 16 and safety; and 17 WHEREAS, there were present an immediate need for protecting County property; and 18 WHEREAS, the Director of Internal Services/Chief Information Officer, in conjunction with 19 the County Administrative Officer, declared the situation to be an emergency; and 20 WHEREAS, contractors were engaged to perform work necessary for taking the necessary 21 steps to protect County property; and 22 WHEREAS, the nature of the emergencies are such that immediate remediation and 23 restoration were necessary; and 24 WHEREAS, the cost of remediation and restoration will exceed the deductibles on the 25 County's insurance policies and will be paid for by insurance proceeds; 26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all of the foregoing recitals are true and 27 correct. 28

1	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the procurement of services to provide for the				
2	remediation and protection of County property without competitive bidding was in the best interest of				
3	the County due to the immediate need to obtain services for the protection of County Property.				
4	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the interests of the County in restoring and reconstructing				
5	County property will be best served through a negotiated contract without competitive bidding by				
6	working with and through the County's property insurance carrier.
