WHEREAS, Section 12(b) of the Fresno County Charter authorizes the Board of Supervisors to provide, by Ordinance or Resolution, for the compensation of elected County Department Heads; and

WHEREAS, Section 12(b) of the Fresno County Charter also requires the setting of the salaries of elected County Department Heads to occur prior to the commencement of the term of office and no later than sixty (60) days prior to the primary election for the elected officers; and

WHEREAS, Board of Supervisors' Administrative Policy Number 58 requires the County Administrative Officer to bring an agenda item to the Board to set the salaries of elective officers of the County no later than 143 days before the primary election (or no later than the first meeting of the calendar year for a June primary); and

WHEREAS, on October 31, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved amendments to the County of Fresno Ordinance Code to repeal the consolidation of the District Attorney-Public Administrator elective offices and to consolidate the Sheriff-Coroner and Public Administrator elective offices to be operative with the commencement of the new terms of office in January 2019,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Fresno County Board of Supervisors as follows:

- I. The Assessor-Recorder shall receive an annual salary as follows:
 - a. Effective January 7, 2019, \$152,214.

1 b. Effective January 1st of 2020, 2021, and 2022, the salary then being
2 received shall be increased by a percentage thereof equal to the
3 increase, if any, during the preceding twelve-month period in the
4 California Weighted Consumer Price Index – Urban Wage Earners
5 and Clerical Workers, as compiled and last reported by the California
6 Department of Industrial Relations prior to the preceding October 31st;
7 provided, however, that any increase shall not exceed three percent
8 (3%).

9 II. The Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector shall receive an annual
10 salary as follows:

11 a. Effective January 7, 2019, \$164,408.

12 b. Effective January 1st of 2020, 2021, and 2022, the salary then being
13 received shall be increased by a percentage thereof equal to the
14 increase, if any, during the preceding twelve-month period in the
15 California Weighted Consumer Price Index – Urban Wage Earners
16 and Clerical Workers, as compiled and last reported by the California
17 Department of Industrial Relations prior to the preceding October 31st;
18 provided, however, that any increase shall not exceed three percent
19 (3%).

20 III. The County Clerk shall receive an annual salary as follows:

21 a. Effective January 7, 2019, \$132,372.

22 b. Effective January 1st of 2020, 2021, and 2022, the salary then being
23 received shall be increased by a percentage thereof equal to the
24 increase, if any, during the preceding twelve-month period in the
25 California Weighted Consumer Price Index – Urban Wage Earners
and Clerical Workers, as compiled and last reported by the California

1 Department of Industrial Relations prior to the preceding October 31st;
2 provided, however, that any increase shall not exceed three percent
3 (3%).

4 IV. The District Attorney shall receive an annual salary as follows:

- 5 a. Effective January 7, 2019, \$181,476.
- 6 b. Effective January 1st of 2020, 2021, and 2022, the salary then being
7 received shall be increased by a percentage thereof equal to the
8 increase, if any, during the preceding twelve-month period in the
9 California Weighted Consumer Price Index – Urban Wage Earners
10 and Clerical Workers, as compiled and last reported by the California
11 Department of Industrial Relations prior to the preceding October 31st;
12 provided, however, that any increase shall not exceed three percent
13 (3%).

14 V. The Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator shall receive an annual salary
15 as follows:

- 16 a. Effective January 7, 2019, \$178,352.
- 17 b. Effective January 1st of 2020, 2021, and 2022, the salary then being
18 received shall be increased by a percentage thereof equal to the
19 increase, if any, during the preceding twelve-month period in the
20 California Weighted Consumer Price Index – Urban Wage Earners
21 and Clerical Workers, as compiled and last reported by the California
22 Department of Industrial Relations prior to the preceding October 31st;
23 provided, however, that any increase shall not exceed three percent
24 (3%).
