Cedar in the City of Fresno; and 11 WHEREAS, on October fourth, 2017, County staff discovered flooding in the University 12 Medical Center. The flood began on the sixth floor and leaked through the lower floors, ending at the 13 basement floor; and 14 WHEREAS, there were present an immediate need for preservation of public health, welfare, 15 and safety; and 16 WHEREAS, there were present an immediate need for protecting County property; and 17 WHEREAS, the Director of Internal Services/Chief Information Officer, in conjunction with 18 the County Administrative Officer, declared the situation to be an emergency; and 19 WHEREAS, contractors were engaged to perform work necessary for taking the necessary 20 steps to protect County property; and 21 WHEREAS, the nature of the emergencies are such that immediate remediation and restoration was necessary; and 23 WHEREAS, the cost of remediation and restoration will exceed the deductibles on the 24 County's insurance policies and will be paid for by insurance proceeds; 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all of the foregoing recitals are true and 26 correct. 27 28

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the procurement of services to provide for the remediation and protection of County property without competitive bidding was in the best interest of the County due to the immediate need to obtain services for the protection of County Property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the interests of the County in restoring County property will be best served through a negotiated contract without competitive bidding by working with and through the County's property insurance carrier.
