11	WHEREAS, the Mayors of Kerman, Orange Cove, Parlier, Sanger, San Joaquin and the Fresno
12	Council of Governments, under the leadership of the Mayor from Huron, successfully advocated that the disadvantaged communities of the County of Fresno be included in the Phase I Zero Emissions Vehicle
13	Investment Plan of Electrify America, a subsidiary company of Volkswagen; and WHEREAS, if approved, the measure would also appropriate from the bonds issued and sold
14 15	\$675,000,000 for Sustainable Groundwater Management Act implementation programs and projects intended to stabilize groundwater levels in overdraft groundwater basins.
16 17 18	<b>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED</b> on this 21 <sup>st</sup> day of August 2018, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno supports the installation of new electric vehicle chargers at potential, rural Fresno County Public Library branches, if funding becomes available, to expand the electric vehicle charging infrastructure to benefit the residents of the County of Fresno.
