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7	WHEREAS, the County is the owner of surplus real property located at 472 Rio Frio
8	Street, Mendota, CA 93640 (APN 013-214-08), consisting of a 3 bedroom, 2 bathroom,
9	1,297 square foot home on a 7500 square foot lot, described in the attached Exhibit 1; and
10	WHEREAS, the County Community Development Division of Public Works and
11	Planning (Community Development) financed a loan through the County's HOME Investments
12	Partnership (HOME) program; and
13	WHEREAS, the County acquired the property by Trustee's Sale on June 25, 2018, due
14	to the default on the loan; and
15	FURTHER, persons wishing to bid on the property must comply with the following
16	instructions:
17	1. The minimum bid for the property is \$90,000.
18	2. All written bids shall be delivered to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors by 9:00 a.m.
19	the day of the auction in a sealed envelope labeled "Bid for 472 Rio Frio St, Mendota"
20	accompanied by a certified or cashier's check in the sum of \$9,000 payable to the County of
21	Fresno.
22	3. The Board upon the opening of written bids will ask for oral bids. All oral bidders who
23	have not made a deposit must present a certified or cashier's check in the sum of \$9,000
24	payable to the County of Fresno upon making an oral bid. The starting oral bid must be at least
25	five percent (5%) over the highest written bid accepted.
26	4. All unsuccessful bidders will have their checks returned to them upon completion of
27	bidding. The \$9,000 deposit by the successful bidder is non-refundable.
28	5. The Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids if it deems it best for the public

interest. All proceedings for the sale of this property will be in accordance with the provisions 1 2 of California Government Code.

3 6. The successful bidder shall pay to the County the entire remaining balance of the 4 purchase amount within fifteen (15) days after acceptance of the highest bid. Upon receiving 5 the full purchase amount, the County will deliver to the purchaser by Grant Deed free and clear 6 of encumbrances, except as apparent or of record, in "as is" condition.

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7. In the event the first bidder cannot meet the requirements and deadlines of the sale, the 8 Board may later award the bid to the runner-up bidder under the same terms as stated herein. 9 Under such an event, the first bidder forfeits the \$9,000 deposit.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the above described parcel is declared 11 surplus and is to be sold in accordance with the provisions of this Resolution.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said surplus property shall be sold by public auction 13 to be held in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, Room 301, Hall of Records, 2281 Tulare 14 Street, Fresno, California on October 23, 2018, at the hour of 9:00 a.m.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the property shall be sold in "as is" condition.


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the conditions of the sale are that the County of Fresno 17 shall deliver to the purchaser a good and sufficient grant deed conveying the property to the 18 purchaser free and clear of encumbrances except easements apparent or of record, in "as is" 19 condition.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of the adoption of this Resolution and the time 21 and place of opening of bids shall be given by the Clerk of the Board by posting copies of the 22 Resolution signed by the Chairman of the Board in three places in the County of Fresno not 23 less than fifteen (15) days prior to the date of said meeting and by publishing a notice once a 24 week for at least three successive weeks prior to said meeting in the Fresno Business Journal, 25 a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Fresno.
