





LOCATION MAP



EXISTING LAND USE MAP




EXISTING ZONING





I want to Thank You, for taking the time to read my letter and I am hoping you will show support for all the stray and abandoned animals in this area.



The District has reviewed the above referenced development, along with the mitigated negative declaration and the District takes a neutral position on the project. Dear Chairman Quintero,

As a lifelong Valley resident, I have always presumed that pet overpopulation and sky-high euthanasia rates were just an unfortunate part of life here in this great County. However, as I have become increasingly more involved in animal advocacy, I see that Fresno County's inability to care for its voiceless animal cohabitants has been horrific and by no means typical when compared to other counties in the nation. Enter: Fresno Humane Animal Services.

Fresno Humane Animal Services is a beacon of light in a County that holds little value for the care and livelihood of our animals. Every rescue or animal advocate knows that when you need help, you should call Fresno Humane for the best chance of saving the life in question. It is well-known that the only other local organization for this type of service is tantamount to a death sentence for any animal, the logistics of which I will not go into here. As Fresno Humane becomes increasingly well-known as the savior for our animal friends, I can only imagine the increased burden this puts on their shelter. Their need for expansion is *critical*, as they have become the only hope for our great County that just can't seem to get pet overpopulation under control. If we have any chance of bettering this rampant pet overpopulation, it is through the expansion of the Fresno Humane shelter.

While I am tempted to tug at your heartstrings and remind you how incredibly loving and life-changing these animals can be and how insurmountably tragic it is that dozens, if not hundreds, are killed senselessly *every day* simply due to "lack of space," I understand that there are logistics in play that go beyond any emotional sentiment. Therefore, please consider the crisis-level strain that is put on our animal service agencies on a daily basis that requires an immediate call to action. A call which Fresno Humane is begging to answer, but cannot answer without your vote.

It will take a lot of work and a lot of time to get these pet overpopulation issues under control, but the only way to take that first step is to support Fresno Humane in this endeavor. I fear that there will be no hope left for Fresno County if this critical first step is not approved.

I thank you deeply for taking the time to read this plea, and I beg you to consider the approval of this item as a necessity for the thousands of lives that are in your hands.

l am writing to you to express my support for the applications that will provide the necessary land use approvals for a proposed "Animal Shelter/Hospital" on 4-acres of land in the northwest area of the community. It is my understanding that the proposal will be coming to your Board for consideration of both the Staff and Planning Commission recommendations on September 11, 2018.

In my opinion, this project has been carefully designed by the applicant and reviewed by your staff, who is recommending "Approval" of the project. Also, the Planning Commission reviewed the proposed project on July 26, 2018, and heard testimony both for and against the proposal. The Commission agreed with the County staff and is recommending approval of the General Plan Amendment and the Amendment Application to rezone the 4-acre project site to the M-1(c) zone district.

This type of use is very much needed in the community, and the location on Grantland Avenue backing up to Freeway 99 seems like a very appropriate location for such a use. The applicant has "conditioned" the County Applications to only allow for one specific use to occur on the site even though the City of Fresno General Plan would allow for a variety of "Non-Residential" uses to occur on the same site. The result of this "Conditioning" is that the future impacts to the area (traffic, noise, etc.) are less than if the site were to develop according to the City's plans.
