RE: Issuance of Liquor License

Transferee of liquor license assures the Board of supervisor of the following;

- 1) Issuance of a license would not create any law enforcement problem. Proposed business location has no history of significant disturbances and illegal activity. There have not been any incidents of public drunkenness, unlawful activities or other disorderly activities. There is no neighborhood concern that issuance of a license will increase the likely hood of disturbances or crime activities.
- 2) Due to increase of population in the surrounding areas, demands for alcoholic beverages are significant for responsible enjoyment. Issuance of license would increase competition as currently there is only one liquor store in the nearby vicinity.
- 3) Issuance of license would increase company sales, increase our profit margins resulting in more tax revenue for local, state and federal agencies. We expect to increase our employment due to likely increase sale revenue.
