1 BEFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 2 OF THE 3 COUNTY OF FRESNO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA 4 5 IN THE MATTER RELATED TO THE FLOOD INCIDENT AT THE FRESNO COUNTY 6 BRIX-MERCER BUILDING RESOLUTION 7 8 9 WHEREAS, the County owns certain real property known as the Fresno County Brix-Mercer 10 Building located at 1221 Fulton Mall Street in the City of Fresno; and 11 WHEREAS, on October 17, 2018, a City of Fresno water main broke outside the Brix-Mercer 12 on the west side of the building causing extensive water damage on multiple floors, submerging the 13 mechanical systems in the building which made them inoperable, and in effect, rendering the entire 14 building inhabitable; and 15 WHEREAS, there was present an immediate need for preservation of public health, welfare, 16 and safety; and 17 WHEREAS, there was present an immediate need for protecting County property; and 18 WHEREAS, the Director of Internal Services/Chief Information Officer (Director/CIO), in 19 conjunction with the County Administrative Officer, declared the situation to be an emergency; and 20 WHEREAS, contractors were engaged by the Director/CIO to perform work necessary for 21 taking the necessary steps to protect County property and employees; and 22 WHEREAS, the nature of the emergency was such that immediate remediation and 23 restoration was and is necessary; and 24 WHEREAS, the cost of remediation and restoration will exceed the deductibles on the 25 County's insurance policies and will be paid for by insurance proceeds; 26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all of the foregoing recitals are true and 27 correct.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the flooding incident at the Brix-Mercer Building was an emergency and the Director/CIO's procurement of all services, equipment, and supplies to provide for the remediation and protection of County property without competitive bidding was and is in the best interest of the County due to the immediate need to obtain services, equipment and supplies for the protection of County property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all of the agreements, contracts and other documents that were approved and entered into by the Director/CIO on behalf of the County for all services, equipment and supplies for the remediation and restoration of the Brix-Mercer Building and protection of County property are hereby ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the interests of the County in restoring County property will be best served through a negotiated contract or contracts approved and entered into by the Director/CIO on behalf of the County without competitive bidding by working with and through the County's property insurance carrier.
