## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that stop signs be installed at the intersection of Leonard and Shields Avenues, making it an all-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Leonard and Shields Avenues is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the County of Fresno.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the intersection of Leonard and Shields Avenues a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of stop signs at the intersection of Leonard and Shields Avenues, stopping eastbound and westbound traffic on Shields Avenue.

THE FOREGOING, was passed and adopted by the following vote of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno this 4th day of December 2018, to wit:


