WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that stop signs be installed at the intersection of American Avenue and Golden State Boulevard, making it an all-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of American Avenue and Golden State Boulevard is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the County of Fresno.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the intersection of American Avenue and Golden State Boulevard a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of stop signs at the intersection of American Avenue and Golden State Boulevard, stopping northbound and southbound traffic on Golden State Boulevard.

THE FOREGOING, was passed and adopted by the following vote of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno this 4th day of December 2018, to wit:




