STOPPING SIGNS ON MAPLE AVENUE, NORTH ) RESOLUTION  
OF CENTRAL AVENUE NEAR THE CUL-DE SAC )

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that NO STOPPING signs be installed on Maple Avenue between, north of Central near the Cul-de-sac, because the signs are necessary to properly indicate and carry out the provisions of the Vehicle Code, necessary to guide traffic, and necessary to prevent motorists from obstructing traffic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors does authorize the installation of NO STOPPING signs on Maple Avenue north of Central Avenue near the Cul-de-sac, to properly indicate and carry out the provisions of the Vehicle Code, to guide traffic, and to prohibit motorists from bringing vehicles to a complete stop upon the highway, which impedes or obstructs the normal and reasonable movement of traffic, unless the stop is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors directs the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning to erect NO STOPPING signs in a manner not inconsistent with this resolution.


