**BIG SISTERS ORGANIZATION** 

WHEREAS, The Big Brothers movement began in Cincinnati, Ohio, in 1903, and the one-to-one philosophy slowly took hold. Thirteen Big Brothers Associations joined forces and formed Big Brothers of America in 1946, one of the few social welfare organizations to be chartered by the Congress of the United States. In 1970, Big Sisters Association became Big Sisters of America, and in 1976 Big Brothers of America and Big Sisters of America merged to become Big Brothers/Big Sisters of America; and

**WHEREAS,** In January 1968, a group of young men representing different backgrounds and vocations decided to help establish this unique social service in Fresno by sponsoring fundraising events and membership drives until sufficient funds were raised to implement a Big Brother program; and

**WHEREAS**, In addition to its Metro Fresno/Clovis Program, the organization extends its services to various rural communities, particularly southeastern and western Fresno County, as well as Madera and Kings Counties; and

**WHEREAS,** Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Fresno County has evolved into a leading organization in the community, a dynamic force striving to improve the quality of life of its members and the general community.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes and celebrates the 50th Anniversary of Fresno County's Big Brothers/Big Sisters organization. This accomplishment is a testimony to the positive role that they play in the lives of children in Fresno County.
