WHEREAS, it appears necessary to acquire by eminent domain certain real property interests for the purpose of constructing the Travers Creek Bridge Replacement Project on Lincoln Avenue, in the County of Fresno, hereinafter referred to as "the Project."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that March 12, 2019, at the hour of 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as practicable, in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno, Room 301, Hall of Records, 2281 Tulare Street, Fresno, California, is hereby set as the time and place of the public hearing to determine whether a resolution of necessity should be adopted as provided by law precedent to the commencement of eminent domain proceedings to acquire the real property interests needed for the Project in accordance with those plans and specifications on file with the County of Fresno Department of Public Works and Planning.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works and Planning of the County of Fresno, is hereby directed to give notice of said public hearing in the manner required by law and that the Design Division of the Department of Public Works and Planning be designated in said notice as the office to answer inquiries regarding the hearing proceedings.


