Dear Mr. White,

In regards to the above referenced item, we respectfully request a continuance as to finalize our analysis of Fresno Metropolitan Flood Control District's (FMFCD) proposed basin "DQ" location.

Fagundes Dairy has property on the west side of the Enterprise Canal and has recently acquired additional acreage all of which can be utilized for a storage/recharge basin. The advantages of this site are that Fresno Irrigation District (FID) has rights to provide water to the west side of the Enterprise Canal which the east side does not enjoy. Additionally in discussions with the City of Clovis, their current trail system is to be located on the west side of the Enterprise Canal which would work better with our proposed basis location and it has less area within Flood Zone A.

We are aware that FMFCD has concerns regarding the sizing of this basin which we understand. This is the reason we are requesting some additional time to analyze both locations. We fully recognize the need for a basin in this area and our goal is to find a location that works best for all parties. We sincerely appreciate your attention to this matter and look forward to identifying the best possible location.
