WHEREAS, The County of Fresno, Sheriff's Office will receive \$100,000 from the SHSP Program to fund the purchase of a bomb truck and associated equipment; and

WHEREAS, said monies are not included in the FY 2018-19 adopted appropriations and estimated revenues of the Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator's Organization 3111; and

WHEREAS, section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2018-19 Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator's Organization 3111 as follows:


