RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the County of Fresno, Aid to Adoptions Organization 6415 requires an additional \$657,289 in appropriations in order to make mandated assistance payments; and

WHEREAS, the Aid to Adoptions will receive \$657,289 in State and Federal revenues to fund the increase in cost; and

WHEREAS, the \$657,289 is not included in the adopted appropriations and estimated revenues of the FY 2018-19 Aid to Adoptions Organization 6415; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2018-19 Aid to Adoptions Organization 6415 as follows:


