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RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE FRESNO COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TO ALLOCATE SPECIFIED FUNDS FROM THE LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FUND AND THE STATE TRANSIT ASSISTANCE FUND TO THE COUNTY OF FRESNO

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8	WHEREAS, the County of Fresno (County) hereby submits a Transportation Funding Claim from
9	the Local Transportation Fund of Fresno County for Fiscal Year 2018-19; and
10	WHEREAS, the Fresno Council of Governments has the authority to review claims and allocate
11	such funds in accordance with the Transportation Development Act of 1971 and Chapter 3 of Title 21 of
12	the California Administrative Code; and
13	WHEREAS, the County agrees to reserve the sum of \$2,583,684 and \$66,386 from its Local
14	Transportation Fund and State Transit Assistance Fund allocations to be claimed by the City of Fresno and
15	the City of Clovis, respectively, as payment for providing transit services to the unincorporated areas within
16	the Fresno-Clovis Metropolitan Area; and
17	WHEREAS, the County agrees to reserve the sum of \$797,390 from its Local Transportation Fund
18	allocation to be claimed by the Fresno County Rural Transit Agency to provide transit services to the rural
19	areas within the County; and
20	WHEREAS, the County agrees to reserve the sum of \$309,461 from its Local Transportation Fund
21	allocation to be claimed by the Clovis Consolidated Transportation Service Agency, the Fresno Urban
22	Consolidated Transportation Services Agency, and the Fresno Rural Consolidated Transportation Services
23	Agency to provide social services transit to the unincorporated areas within the Fresno-Clovis Metropolitan
24	Area and to the rural areas within the County; and
25	WHEREAS, the Fresno Council of Governments encourages inter-jurisdictional coordination of
26	transportation needs and increased coordination of transportation implementation plans; and
27	WHEREAS, the County has made a commitment to unmet transit needs through adoption of a
28	Transportation Development Plan for the County and participation in a Joint Powers Agreement between

1	the County and the cities and communities in the rural portions of the County to provide transit services so
2	that allocation of funds to finance the Joint Powers Agreement satisfies the requirement for establishing a
3	schedule for transit implementation; and
4	WHEREAS, there are no additional unmet transit needs within the County.
5	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Fresno hereby requests the Council of
6	Fresno County Governments direct \$2,583,684, \$66,386, \$797,390, and \$309,461 from the County's
7	Local Transportation Fund and State Transit Assistance Fund allocations to the above named applicants
8	for Fiscal Year 2018-19 for the purposes allowed under ARTICLE 4, ARTICLE 4.5, and ARTICLE 8
9	respectively of the Transportation Development Act of 1971, as identified in the attached claim and which
10	is in accordance with the adopted Regional Transportation Plan.
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the named applicants further agree to provide the Fresno
12	Council of Governments with such information as may be necessary to support their Annual Transportation
13	Claims.
