WHEREAS, there is available fund balance in the Probation Fund 0271 to fund the tool development/implementation and validation of the M-PACT assessment tool; and

WHEREAS, the Youthful Offender Block Grant Organization 3434 requires an increase in appropriations in the amount of \$21,250 to fund an Operating Transfer out to the Probation Organization 3430; and

WHEREAS, \$21,250 is available in the fund balance of the Probation Fund 0271, to fund the additional cost; and

WHEREAS, said monies were not included in the adopted appropriations for the FY 2018-19 Youthful Offender Block Grant Organization 3434; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2018-19 Youthful Offender Block Grant Organization 3434 as follows:


