Re. Beer and Wine License

I have been issued a CUP by the Board of Supervisors resolution 3349 and a copy of the resolution has been submitted to your office. The CUP allows for a minimart with sales of beer and wine, gas station and subway at 50 S. McCall Avenue, Sanger California, at the junction of Route 180 and McCall.

#1 The issuance of type 20 license would provide a needed service to the travelers passing through and local farm labor workers. There will not be any additional alcohol-related services and hence no criminal or law enforcement problems will be expected.

#2 Junction of Route 180 and McCall is one of the busiest junctions for traffic and it will provide a one-stop service solution to the highway travelers, local travelers and farm labor workers in the area. At present there is no similar one-stop service available locally.

#3 The issuance of a Beer and Wine license at this location would have a positive impact on the local economy bringing more tax funds to the County of Fresno and supporting the local economy of this area. Being a central place between Fresno and Sanger it will provide much-needed services to the travelers from Fresno, Clovis, Sanger and Selma.
