### FRESNO COUNTY POLICY MANAGEMENT DIRECTIVE 2400

- The issuance of a license would not tend to create a law enforcement problem and increase the level of crime activity.
- 2. The issuance of a license would provide a needed service to the community and that without this use there would be an inconvenience to the community.
- The issuance of a license will have a positive impact on the local economy including the creation of new jobs.



#### **STATISTICS**

- Applicant is in Census Tract 59.05
- \* 6 off-sale licenses are allowed by ABC in this census tract
- \* There is one existing off-sale license in this census tract, and one pending license.
- \* There is a moratorium on the issuance of off-sale (Type 20) licenses for Fresno County where the ratio of licenses exceeds one for each 2,500 inhabitants.
- Due to this moratorium, ABC must deny the application unless your Board determines that public convenience or necessity would be served by the issuance


