## Letter of Intent

### 1. Statement of Need

This cover letter is to respectfully request assistance from the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways, for the purchase of a new patrol vessel. If selected, the Fresno County Sheriff's Office will replace one of its five lake patrol boats. The vessel to be replaced is currently twenty-four years old and has become an unreliable patrol / rescue vessel.

The specific vessel we are requesting to replace is a 1995 20'0" Design Concepts, aluminum hull, deep vee bottom, with a 350ci V8 inboard/outboard motor. This vessel currently has over 3,850 hours, and in the last 550 hours of use has accumulated over \$19,000 in repairs and service. These repairs are significant and have caused the vessel to be out of service for long periods of time. Nearly all the repairs to this vessel are related to engine and outdrive wear and tear. With the number of boaters on Fresno County's waterways increasing it is imperative we have reliable vessels for patrol and responding to emergencies.

If granted, the new patrol vessel will be assigned to one of nine lakes within Fresno County. The new vessel will be operated in waterways ranging in elevation from 100' to 8,000' with the sea states ranging from six inch choppy waves to four foot swells. Our lakes have severe weather changes during the summer and winter. Shaver Lake is located at approximately 5600' in elevation. It is located in the Sierra Nevada Mountains and experiences periods of extremely dense fog, high winds, and snow. Pine Flat Lake is a lower elevation lake at about 500' and holds about one million acre feet of water. Pine Flat Lake experiences extreme heat during the summer months, upwards of 115 degrees with little to no shade.

The addition of a new boat to our aging fleet, it will dramatically increase our ability to deliver effective and efficient service to the citizens of Fresno County.

The details of the proposed replacement vessel are as follows:

- 22-24 foot aluminum hull, outboard motor with at least 300hp.
- Boat cover
- Boat trailer

The estimated cost for the above listed items is \$139,261.00.

### 3. Describe your agency's boating safety and enforcement activities

The Fresno County Sheriff's Office Boating Enforcement Unit consists of one full-time Sergeant and two full-time Deputy Sheriffs who work in the unit year round. During the peak summer months, between May and September, the unit hires four additional Deputy Sheriff's and six paid Reserve Deputies.

During the summer boating season six, two-person teams patrol at least forty hours a week on the County's eleven waterways. The Boating Enforcement Unit enforces all Federal, State, and County regulations relating to all water and boating activities. The unit is responsible for all water related search and rescue operations, drowned body recoveries, and vessel accident investigation. The unit is very proactive, conducting over 1,200 vessel inspections during the 2017 – 2018 fiscal year. Throughout the year deputies also participate in numerous parades, outdoor community events, and water safety presentations.

**5. Describe the recreational boating activity on your waterways:**

At 6,000 square miles, Fresno County is the fifth largest county in California. As such, it has many recreational boating waterways and opportunities available for public use. Fresno County contains nine lakes and two rivers for boaters to utilize, totaling approximately 129 miles of navigable waters. The lakes and sloughs of Fresno County provide recreational boaters with approximately 27 square miles of water. These waterways range in elevation from approximately 100' to 8,000'. The County's largest lake, Pine Flat Lake, holds about one million acre feet of water and occupies 9.5 square miles. Another popular Fresno County lake, Shaver Lake, has seen a 400% increase in recreational boating activity over the course of the past ten years. Most Fresno County waterways are used on a year round basis, though the busiest recreational use takes place between Memorial Day and Labor Day.
