17	governing the application, awarding, and management of grants; and		
18	WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an		
19	applicant's governing body to authorize by resolution its approval for submittal of grant applications,		
20	and the designation by job title of the individuals authorized to execute all grant documents on behalf of		
21	the County of Fresno (County); and		
22	WHEREAS, if awarded, the County will enter into grant agreements with CalRecycle for		
23	implementation of said grants.		
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors		
25	authorizes the submittal of application(s) to CalRecycle for Local Enforcement Agency Grant Program		
26	grants for which the County is eligible for FYs 2019-20 through 2023-24; and		
27	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Fresno County Board of Supervisors, or		
28	designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute on behalf of the County all grant		

1	documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for		
2	payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant projects; and		
3	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorizations are effective from May 14, 2019 through		
4	May 13, 2024.
