9 WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the Off-Highway Motor  
10 Vehicles Recreation Act of 2003, which provides funds to the State of California and its political  
11 subdivisions for operation and maintenance, restoration, law enforcement, and education and safety  
12 for off-highway vehicle recreation; and

13 WHEREAS, the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division of the California Department  
14 of Parks and Recreation has been delegated the responsibility to administer the program; and

15 WHEREAS, procedures established by the California Department of Parks and Recreation  
16 require the applicant's governing body to certify by resolution the approval of the application to apply  
17 for Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Grant funds; and

18 WHEREAS, this project appears on, or is in conformance with this jurisdiction's adopted  
19 general or master plan and is compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions immediately  
20 surrounding the Project;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby:

- 22 1. Approves the filing of an application for an Off-Highway Vehicle Grant; and
- 23 2. Certifies that this agency understands its legal obligations to the State upon  
24 approval of the Grant; and
- 25 3. Certifies that this agency understands the California Public Resources Code  
26 requirement that acquisition and development projects be maintained to

- Specific conservation standards; and
- 4. Certifies that the project will be well-maintained during its useful life; and
- 5. Certifies that this agency will provide the required matching funds; and
- 6. Appoints the Sheriff as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for completion of the project, but not including agreements and amendments.
