WHEREAS, the CalVCB has authorized and allocated \$63,596 for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, \$63,596 for the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, and \$63,596 for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 to continue this Program, subject to the execution of a Grant Agreement and all required certifications (collectively, the "Grant Agreement"), and acknowledgment of the terms and conditions contained therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the County Board is authorized to execute the Grant Agreement on behalf of the County of Fresno, and the District Attorney of the County of Fresno is authorized to submit the Grant Agreement to the CalVCB.
