

1 B. A misfortune or calamity.

2 C. A misfortune or calamity that, with respect to a possessory interest in land owned by
3 the state or federal government, has caused the permit or other right to enter upon
4 the land to be suspended or restricted. As used in this paragraph, "misfortune or
5 calamity" includes a drought condition such as existed in this state in 1976 and 1977.

6 **4.57.040 – Reassessment.**

7 Upon receiving a proper application or making a determination under section 4.57.020,
8 the assessor shall make a reassessment and provide notice as provided in section 170
9 of the Revenue and Taxation Code.

10
11 **Section 2.** This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after the date of its final passage.
