<u>IN THE AMOUNT OF \$170,000)</u>	

WHEREAS, the County of Fresno, Security Services, Organization (Org) 8970, requires an increase in appropriations in the amount of \$170,000 to allow for the payment of costs related to negotiated rate increases in parking agreements with the City of Fresno and the on-going costs of alarm services including inspection, repairs and replacement necessary to meet departmental demands and use; and

WHEREAS, said additional costs will be financed by revenue from user County Departments and County employees benefiting from said alarm services and parking in the amount of \$170,000; and

WHEREAS, said monies are not included in the adopted appropriations and estimated revenues of the FY 2018-19 Security Services, Org 8970 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a 4/5ths vote by the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in FY 2018-19 Security Services, Org 8970 as follows:
