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#### AMENDMENT I TO AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into this 4th day of June, 2019, by and between the COUNTY OF FRESNO, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and each Contractor listed in Revised Exhibit A, "Non-DMC Youth Treatment Services Vendor List,", attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, collectively hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR", and such additional CONTRACTORs as may, from time to time during the term of this Agreement, be added by COUNTY. Reference in this Agreement to "party" or "parties" shall be understood to refer to COUNTY and each CONTRACTOR, unless otherwise specified.

WHEREAS, the parties entered into that certain Agreement, identified as COUNTY Agreement No. 18-694, effective January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR(s) agreed to provide outpatient alcohol and substance use disorder (SUD) treatment services to Fresno County minors between the ages of 12 and 17 years old; and

WHEREAS the parties desire to amend the Agreement, regarding changes as stated below and restate the Agreement in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of their mutual promises, covenants and conditions, hereinafter set forth, the sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

That the existing COUNTY agreement No. 18-694, Paragraph Five (5) – COMPENSATION
 in the Agreement on Page Five (5), beginning on Line Eight (8) with the word "In" and ending on Line
 Thirteen (13) with the word "available" be deleted in its entirety and the following inserted in its place:

"In no event shall the total compensation for actual service performed under this Agreement be in excess of Five Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Three and No/100 Dollars (\$598,883.00) for the first six (6) month period from January 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019 and One Million Two Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-Two and No/100 Dollars (\$1,234,432.00) for each twelve (12) month period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2023. CONTRACTOR shall be reimbursed to the extent that funds are available."

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2. That the existing COUNTY agreement No. 18-694, Paragraph Eighteen – INSURANCE – be amended starting on Page Fifteen (15), Line Twenty-Seven (27) after the word "basis" by inserting the following:

#### "F. Cyber Liability

Cyber Liability Insurance, with limits not less than \$2,000,000 per occurrence or claim, \$2,000,000 aggregate. Coverage shall be sufficiently broad to respond to the duties and obligations as is undertaken by CONTRACTOR in this agreement and shall include, but not be limited to, claims involving infringement of intellectual property, including but not limited to infringement of copyright, trademark, trade dress, invasion of privacy violations, information theft, damage to or destruction of electronic information, release of private information, alteration of electronic information, extortion and network security. The policy shall provide coverage for breach response costs as well as regulatory fines and penalties as well as credit monitoring expenses with limits sufficient to respond to these obligations."

- 3. That all references in the Agreement to "Exhibit A" shall be changed to read "Revised Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree that this Amendment I is sufficient to amend Agreement No. 18-694, and that upon execution of this Amendment, Agreement and Amendment I together shall be considered the Agreement.
- 5. The Agreement, as hereby amended, is ratified and continued. All provisions, terms, covenants, conditions, and promises contained in the Agreement and not amended herein shall remain in full force and effect. This Amendment I shall be retroactively effective January 1, 2019.
