WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that a stop sign be installed at the intersection of Caruthers and Walnut Avenues, making it a one-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Caruthers and Walnut Avenues is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the County of Fresno.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the intersection of Caruthers and Walnut Avenues a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of a stop sign at the intersection of Caruthers and Walnut Avenues, stopping southbound traffic on Walnut Avenue.


