WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that a stop sign be installed at the intersection of Rio Vista and Trimmer Springs Avenues, making it a one-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Rio Vista and Trimmer Springs Avenues is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the County of Fresno.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the intersection of Rio Vista and Trimmer Springs Avenues a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of a stop sign at the intersection of Rio Vista and Trimmer Springs Avenues, stopping northbound traffic on Rio Vista Avenue.


