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7	WHEREAS, the State of California, Department of Housing and Community Development
8	("Department") issued a Notice of Funding Availability, dated October 15, 2018 as amended on October
9	25, 2018 ("NOFA"), under the No Place Like Home Program ("NPLH" or "Program") authorized by
10	Government Code section 15463, Part 3.9 of Division 5 (commencing with Section 5849.1) of the
11	Welfare and Institutions Code, and Welfare and Institutions Code section 5890;
12	WHEREAS, the Initial NOFA relates to the availability of approximately \$400 million in
13	Competitive Allocation funds under the NPLH Program; and
14	WHEREAS, Fresno is a County and an Applicant, as those terms are defined in the NPLH
15	Program Guidelines, dated July 17, 2017 ("Guidelines").
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors does
17	hereby determine and declare as follows:
18	SECTION 1. That County is hereby authorized and directed to apply for and if awarded, accept
19	the NPLH Program funds, as detailed in the Initial NOFA, up to the amount authorized by the
20	Guidelines and applicable state law.
21	SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Fresno County Board of Supervisors, or his or her
22	designee, is hereby authorized and directed to act on behalf of County in connection with an award of
23	NPLH Program funds, and to enter into, execute, and deliver any and all documents required or deemed
24	necessary or appropriate to evidence the loan of NPLH Program funds, the County's obligations related
25	thereto, and the Department's security therefore. These documents may include, but are not limited to, a
26	State of California Standard Agreement ("Standard Agreement"), a regulatory agreement, a promissory
27	note, a deed of trust and security agreement, and any and all other documents required or deemed
28	necessary or appropriate by the Department as security for, evidence of, or pertaining to the NPLH
	Program funds, and all amendments thereto (collectively, the "NPLH Program Documents").

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1	SECTION 3. That County shall be subject to the terms and conditions that are specified in the
2	Standard Agreement; that the application in full is incorporated as part of the Standard Agreement; that
3	any and all activities funded, information provided, and timelines represented in the application are
4	enforceable through the Standard Agreement; and that County will use the NPLH Program funds in
5	accordance with the Guidelines, other applicable rules and laws, the NPLH Program Documents, and
6	any and all NPLH Program requirements.
7	SECTION 4. That County will make mental health supportive services available to each project's
8	NPLH tenants for at least 20 years, and will coordinate the provision of or referral to other services
9	(including, but not limited to, substance use services) in accordance with the County's relevant supportive
10	services plan, and as specified in Section 202(n)(1) of the Guidelines.
