WHEREAS, the Capital Projects Fund 0400, Animal Control Facility Org 8855 had previously received funds from the Interest and Miscellaneous Expenditures Organization 2540 for the Board-approved Animal Control Facility project, in the amount of \$495,000; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Projects Fund 0400, Animal Control Facility Org 8855 requires \$495,000 to complete the real property purchase transaction; and

WHEREAS, \$495,000 is available in the fund balance of the Capital Projects Fund 0400, Animal Control Facility Org 8855 to fund these expenditures; and

WHEREAS, said monies were not included in the appropriations for the FY 2019-20 Capital Projects Fund 0400, Animal Control Facility Org 8855; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2019-20 Capital Projects Fund 0400, Animal Control Facility Org 8855, as follows:
