

The Process for Removing Encampments

- Special Agents OR ANYONE can provide me with an assessment
 - L/L
 - Location description
 - Trees/Foliage removal
 - Number of pick-up truck loads
 - Photos
 - Engineering Protection? (Flag, Track and Time, Spiked track, etc.)
 - Call ticket
- RFP's with potential biohazard, environmental, and/or ecological issues
- Selection of contractor
- Schedule Clean-up (within 2 weeks of initial report of encampment)
 - Track and time, flag protection, etc. (25' rule)
 - External variables: local govts, advocacy groups, media, etc.
- Job Completion
 - After photos
 - Report submitted to Chief of Police
