DELEGATION TO THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND PLANNING OF AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE INDIVIDUAL PROJECT SPECIFIC SUPPLEMENT AGREEMENTS PURSUANT TO THE MASTER DUAL JURISDICTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF FRESNO RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND PLANNING TO EXECUTE INDIVIDUAL PROJECT SPECIFIC SUPPLEMENT AGREEMENTS AS DESCRIBED IN THE MASTER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY AND THE CITY OF FRESNO

WHEREAS, the City of Fresno (City) and the County of Fresno (County) recognize that it will be to their mutual benefit to perform, as a cooperative endeavor, certain construction projects for the improvement, repair or maintenance of roads and associated traffic signals, bridges, and facilities located across City/County jurisdictional boundaries, as to which the City and County share jurisdictional responsibility ("Projects"); and

WHEREAS, both the City and the County desire to streamline the process by which City and County may enter into cooperative agreements for the construction of such dual jurisdiction projects (Projects); and,

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2017, the Board gave its conceptual approval to a proposal to develop a "master agreement" relating to such Projects; and,

WHEREAS, the approach approved by the Board at that time also contemplated the delegation to the Director of the County's Department of Public Works and Planning (Director) of authority to execute, on the County's behalf, each Project Specific Supplement Agreement (PSS) setting forth the additional terms and conditions defining each agency's respective responsibilities and share of costs for each such individual Project, subject to prior approval by the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector and County Counsel; and.

WHEREAS, the City and the County have developed a Master Dual Jurisdiction Cooperative Agreement ("Master Agreement"), establishing certain terms associated with the construction of such Projects and the template to be used for each PSS for any such Projects; and

WHEREAS, the City approved the Master Agreement on July 25, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of the County's Department of Public Works and Planning to enter into and execute on the County's behalf, subject to prior approval by the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector and County Counsel, Project Specific Supplement Agreements with the City of Fresno, pursuant to the terms, conditions, and limitations established by the Master Dual Jurisdiction Cooperative Agreement executed between the County and the City of Fresno and approved by this Board on September 10, 2019; and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that each such PSS will incorporate all provisions of the Master Agreement to the extent not expressly modified by the PSS, and will set forth those additional provisions defining each agency's respective responsibilities and share of costs for each such Project, and will be consistent with the PSS template presented to this Board on September 10, 2019.
