6	THE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENT PERMIT UNDER CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD CENTRAL VALLEY REGION ORDER NO. 95-263 FOR COUNTY
7	SERVICE AREA NO. 31, ZONE B (SHAVER LAKE VILLAGE & CAMP EDISON)
8	WHEREAS, the State of California Regional Water Quality Control Board ("RWQCB"), under
9	Water Code, section 13263, subdivision (e), mandates periodic updates and amendments to existing
10	wastewater discharge requirement ("WDR") permits; and
11	WHEREAS, the RWQCB provides a process to update WDR permits for domestic systems with
12	a monthly average flow rate over 100,000 gallons per day that discharge to land through coverage
13	under RWQCB Central Valley Region Order No. 95-263; and
14	WHEREAS, the County operated-facility in County Service Area No. 31, Zone B (Shaver Lake)
15	("CSA 31B – Shaver Lake Village and Camp Edison") currently has WDR permit coverage under Order
16	95-263 and require updates, amendments, or both to their WDR permit; and
17	WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors may authorize the Director of the Department of Public
18	Works and Planning ("Director"), or designee, to execute and submit documents on behalf of the
19	County of Fresno for updates to the WDR permit; and
20	WHEREAS, it is necessary to ensure the County of Fresno's timely action with respect to the
21	updates, amendments, or both, to the WDR permit in order to avoid compliance orders and fines from
22	the RWQCB;
23	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Public Works and
24	Planning, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute and submit documents to the RWQCB that are
25	necessary to update the WDR permit to continue operating the CSA 31B – Shaver Lake Village and
26	Camp Edison wastewater facility.
