6	WHEREAS, National Runaway Prevention Month began in 2002, in partnership with the National Runaway Safeline (NRS) and Fresno EOC Sanctuary and Support Services is committed to protecting our youth and young adults and ending youth homelessness by 2020; and

9	WHEREAS, the prevalence of runaway and homelessness among youth is staggering, with studies suggesting that every year, 4.2 million people ages 13 – 25 endure some form of homelessness; and

11	WHEREAS, in 2018, the California Department of Justice reported Fresno County had 3,718 runaway youth; often this could include youth who are expelled from their home; have experienced abuse and trauma; are involved in the foster care system; are too poor to secure their own basic needs; and may be ineligible or unable to access adequate medical or mental health resources; and

15	WHEREAS, effective programs like Sanctuary and Support Services who operates the Sanctuary Youth Shelter and Sanctuary Transitional Shelter provided emergency shelter for over 350 runaway, homeless or at risk youth and young adults ages 12-24 in 2018; administers a network of 300 Safe Place sites providing immediate access to youth in crisis; operates Central Valley Against Human Trafficking which assists victims of all forms of human trafficking; and operates the newest LGBTQ+ Resource Center providing a safe space for members of the LGBT community; and WHEREAS, Sanctuary and Support Services, along with National Runaway Safeline is honoring November as the National Runaway Prevention Month to raise awareness of the issues facing runaway and homeless youth, and educate the public about solutions and the role they can play in ending youth homelessness.
