21	sufficient cause for the Fresno County of Governments Policy Board to terminate an agency's project						
22	and reprogram Federal/State funds as deemed necessary.						
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County of Fresno Board of Supervisors hereby directs						
24	staff to ensure all projects are carried out in a timely manner per the requirements of AB 1012 and the						
25	directive of the County of Fresno Board of Supervisors.
