Note: Government Code Section 87306 requires that when an agency (e.g., your department) has determined that amendments or revisions are necessitated by changed circumstances, the amendments or revisions shall be submitted to the code reviewing body within 90 days after the changed circumstances have become apparent.


EXHIBIT “B”

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES

1. Persons in this category shall disclose all reportable investments, interests in real property, sources of income (including gifts), and business positions. Financial interests (other than gifts) are reportable only if located within or subject to the jurisdiction of Fresno County, or if the business entity is doing business or planning to do business in the jurisdiction, or has done business within the jurisdiction at any time during the two years prior to the filing of the statement. Real property shall be deemed to be within the jurisdiction of the County if the property or any part of it is located within or not more than two miles outside the boundaries of the County (including its incorporate cities) or within two miles of any land owned or used by the County.
2. Persons in this category shall disclose all reportable investments in, income from (including gifts), and business positions with any business entity which, within the last two years, has contracted or in the future foreseeably may contract with Fresno County to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment to the Veteran’s Services unit of the Department of Social Services.
3. Persons in this category shall disclose all reportable investments in, income from (including gifts), and business positions with any business entity which, within the last two years, has contracted or in the future foreseeably may contract with Fresno County to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment to the Department of Social Services.
