BEFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO STATE OF CALIFORNIA

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER EXCHANGE CONTRACTORS GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY'S GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY PLAN FOR PORTIONS OF THE DELTA-MENDOTA GROUNDWATER SUBBASIN INCLUDING FRESNO COUNTY MANAGEMENT AREA B

WHEREAS, the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act of 2014 (Water Code sections 10720 – 10737.8) ("SGMA"), signed into law on September 16, 2014, requires that each California groundwater basin or subbasin be managed by a Groundwater Sustainability Agency ("GSA"), or multiple GSAs, and that such management be implemented pursuant to an approved Groundwater Sustainability Plan ("GSP") or multiple GSPs; and

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Water Resources requires that each California groundwater basin or subbasin be managed by a GSA or multiple GSAs; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2017, the County elected to serve as the GSA for those portions of the Delta – Mendota (DWR Bulletin 118 Basin No. 5 - 22.07) located within its jurisdictional boundaries that the Board designated as "Management Area B of the Delta-Mendota Subbasin"; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Water Resources designated the Delta-Mendota Subbasin a High Priority basin; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to SGMA the basin is subject to State Intervention if, after January 31, 2020, none of the following have occurred: (A) A groundwater sustainability agency has adopted a groundwater sustainability plan for the entire basin; or (B) a collection of local agencies has adopted groundwater sustainability plans that collectively serve as a groundwater sustainability plan for the entire basin; or (C) the Department of Water Resources has approved an alternative pursuant to Water Code section 10733.6; and

WHEREAS, the County executed a Memorandum of Understanding with the San Joaquin River Exchange Contractors Water Authority (SJRECWA), on March 15, 2016, which, among other things, memorialized an agreement pursuant to which the County agreed to work with the SJRECWA in the

development of a Groundwater Sustainability Plan that would include a Management Area Chapter applicable to Management Area B of the Delta-Mendota Subbasin; and

WHEREAS, SJRECWA, together with the County and other agencies in the Delta-Mendota Subbasin, collectively known as the San Joaquin River Exchange Contractors GSP Group, has caused the preparation of a GSP, which is titled "Delta-Mendota Subbasin (5-022.07) Groundwater Sustainability Plan for: San Joaquin River Exchange Contractors GSP Group," dated July 12, 2019 ("SJREC GSP");

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the SJREC GSP and the Management Area Chapter specifically applicable to the County (Chapter 16) and determined it meets SGMA requirements, including those set forth at Water Code section 10727.2; and

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2019, in accordance with the requirements of Water Code section 10728.4, the County provided notice of its intent to adopt the SJREC GSP at least 90 days before the date of adoption and engaged in all necessary consultation with the cities or counties that requested such consultation; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of Water Code section 10725.2, the County issued notice of its intent to adopt the SJREC GSP on its internet website and provided electronic notice to all parties desiring to receive such notice; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Water Code section 10728.6, adoption of a Groundwater Sustainability Plan is not subject to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act; and

WHEREAS, the County held a public hearing on December 10, 2019, to consider the adoption of this Resolution and its decision to adopt the Groundwater Sustainability Plan and accepted public comment on the same; and

WHEREAS, after considering the issue and allowing for public testimony, the Board of Supervisors determined it to be in the best interest of the County to decide to adopt the SJREC GSP.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED, that County of Fresno hereby adopts the SJREC GSP and will support its continuing development and implementation.
