WHEREAS, there is available fund balance in the Local Revenue Fund 2011 to fund services associated with AB 109 in FY 2019-20, in the amount of \$132,555; and

WHEREAS, Local Community Corrections Organization 3436 requires an increase in appropriations in the amount of \$132,555 to fund an Operating Transfer Out to the Public Defender Organization 2880; and

WHEREAS, \$132,555 is available in the fund balance of the Local Revenue Fund 2011, to fund the additional cost; and

WHEREAS, said monies were not included in the adopted appropriations for the FY 2019-20 Local Community Corrections Organization 3436; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2019-20 Local Community Corrections Organization 3436 as follows:
