- 11. <u>Severable</u>. The provisions of this Agreement are severable. The invalidity or unenforceability of any one provision of this Agreement shall not affect the other provisions.
- 12. <u>Amendment</u>. This Agreement may be modified only by written instrument executed by duly authorized representatives of both City and County.

13. Entire Agreement. Each party acknowledges that it has read and fully understands the contents of this Agreement and represents that this entire Agreement between City and County with respect to the subject matter contained herein and that this Agreement supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, or agreements, either written or oral.
