ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO BY
AMENDING CHAPTER 11.12 OF TITLE 11 THEREOF RELATING TO PARKING OR STOPPING
RESTRICTIONS FOR CERTAIN HIGHWAYS OR PORTIONS THEREOF WITHIN THE
UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno ordains as follows:

Section 1: The Ordinance Code of the County of Fresno is hereby amended by amending Chapter
11.12 of Title 11 thereof to read in its entirety as follows:

CHAPTER 11.12

PARKING OR STOPPING RESTRICTIONS

Sections:

11.12.010 - Narrow Highways

11.12.020 - Hazardous Or Congested Areas

11.12.030 - Temporary Restrictions-Emergencies

11.12.040 - Adjacent To Schools

11.12.050 - Board-Authority

11.12.060 - Snow Removal Conditions

11.12.500 - Violation-Infraction

1 SECTION 11.12.010 - NARROW HIGHWAYS.

- 2 A. The director of public works is authorized to place signs or markings indicating no parking upon
3 any highway when the width of the roadway and shoulders is such that standing or parking a
4 vehicle upon the highway would, in his opinion, constitute a hazard or tend to cause traffic
5 congestion.
- 6 B. When official signs or markings prohibiting parking are erected upon narrow highways as
7 authorized herein, no person shall park or leave standing any vehicle upon such highway in
8 violation of any such sign or marking.

9 SECTION 11.12.020 - HAZARDOUS OR CONGESTED AREAS.

- 10 A. The director of public works is authorized to determine and designate by proper signs and
11 markings places not exceeding two hundred feet in length in which for reasons other than
12 narrowness the standing or parking of vehicles would create an especially hazardous condition
13 or would cause unusual delay to traffic.
- 14 B. When official signs or markings are in place at hazardous or congested places as authorized
15 herein, no person shall stand or park any vehicle in any such designated place.

16 SECTION 11.12.030 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS-EMERGENCIES.

- 17 A. Whenever the director of public works determines that traffic congestion or traffic hazard of an
18 emergency nature is likely to develop from the operation, stopping, standing or parking of
19 vehicles during the holding of public or private assemblages, gatherings or functions, or during
20 the construction, alteration, repair or improvement of any highway or for any other reason, he
21 may place or cause to be placed, temporary signs or signals prohibiting or regulating the
22 operation, stopping, standing or parking of vehicles during the existence of such emergency.
- 23 B. When official signs or signals are in place regulating the operation, stopping, standing or
24 parking of vehicles during the existence of such emergencies, no person shall operate a
25 vehicle contrary to the provisions of such signs or signals.

26 SECTION 11.12.040 - ADJACENT TO SCHOOLS.

- 27 A. The director of public works is authorized to erect signs indicating no standing or parking upon
28 either or both sides of any highway adjacent to any school property when such standing or

1 parking would, in his opinion, interfere with traffic or create a hazardous situation.

- 2 B. When official signs are erected indicating no standing or car parking upon either or both sides
3 of a highway adjacent to any school property as authorized herein, no person shall park or
4 leave standing any vehicle in any such designated place.

5 SECTION 11.12.050 - BOARD-AUTHORITY.

- 6 A. When the board determines by resolution that it is necessary to prohibit standing or parking on
7 certain highways or portions thereof, at all or certain hours of the day, in order to facilitate the
8 movement of traffic or to eliminate a hazardous condition, the director of public works shall
9 appropriately sign or mark such highways or portions thereof.
- 10 B. When official signs or markings are in place pursuant to this section, it is unlawful for any
11 person to stand or park a vehicle on any such highway or portion thereof in violation of the
12 restrictions stated on or indicated by such signs or markings, except that this section does not
13 prohibit buses from stopping to receive or discharge passengers at places appropriately signed
14 or marked as bus loading zones.

15 SECTION 11.12.060 - SNOW REMOVAL CONDITIONS.

- 16 A. The director of public works is authorized to place signs to prohibit or restrict the parking or
17 standing of vehicles on designated streets or highways, or portions thereof, for the purposes of
18 snow removal.
- 19 B. When official signs are erected prohibiting parking when snow removal conditions exist, no
20 person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, within
21 the area marked by signs, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in
22 compliance with the directions of a traffic or peace officer.

23 SECTION 11.12.500 - VIOLATION-INFRACTION.

24 Any person violating any provision of this chapter is guilty of an infraction punishable pursuant to
25 the provisions of Section 1.12.020 of this code.

26 Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its
27 passage.


