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WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure that the residents of Fresno County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in the community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the County must adopt by resolution a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the County will receive an estimated \$19,929,062 in RMRA funding in FY 2020-21 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the fourth year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding and such funding will enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repair and replacement of aging bridges, and will increase access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the County has undergone a public process to ensure public input into the community's transportation priorities and the SB 1 Project List (Exhibit 1); and

WHEREAS, the public process was comprised of the inclusion of the majority of the projects shown on Exhibit 1 in the County's annual Road Improvement Program, adopted pursuant to a duly publicized, regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno; and by the adoption of

this Resolution in a duly publicized, regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement Management System and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) biannual bridge inspection reports to develop the attached SB 1 Project List to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the County maintain, overlay, reconstruct and improve roadways, provide widened paved shoulders, and replace bridges which are structurally deficient, all throughout the County in FY 2020-21, and will facilitate hundreds of similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the County's streets and roads are in at-risk condition, and this revenue will help the County increase the overall quality of the street and road system and over the next decade may help to maintain the overall current condition of the streets and roads, while bringing selected roads into good-to-excellent condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 Project List and overall investment in local street and road infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety and on replacement of aging bridges will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno, State of California, as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- The list of newly proposed projects that will be funded in Fiscal Year 2020-21, partially or entirely with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenue, is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.
- 3. The list of previously proposed and adopted projects for which Fiscal Year 2020-21 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues also may be utilized in their delivery is attached hereto as Exhibit 2. With the relisting of these projects in this adopted fiscal year 2020-21 resolution, the County is reaffirming to the public and the State the intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.
