9 10	WHEREAS, participants from California, Nevada, Colorado, Washington, Tennessee, New York, and Singapore will be supported by almost 200 volunteers during this Fresno County event; and
11	WHEREAS, the Fresno Cycling Club has applied to the State of California to conduct the "Climb to Kaiser" bicycling event on State property; and
12	WHEREAS, the "Climb to Kaiser" bicycling event may temporarily impede and restrict the free
13 14	passage of traffic over State Highway Route 168 on Saturday, June 27, 2020 between Clovis and Kaiser Pass between the hours of 5:30 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
