BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the floodin	g incident at the North Annex Jail was an
nergency, and the ISD Director/CIO's procurement o	f all services, equipment, and supplies to
ovide for the remediation and protection of County p	roperty without competitive bidding was, and

is, in the best interest of the County, due to the immediate need to obtain services, equipment and
supplies, for the protection of County property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all of the agreements, contracts and other documents that were approved and entered into by the ISD Director/CIO on behalf of the County for all services, equipment, and supplies for the remediation and restoration of the North Annex Jail and protection of County property are hereby ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the interests of the County in restoring County property will be best served through a negotiated contract or contracts approved and entered into by the ISD Director/CIO on behalf of the County without competitive bidding, by working with and through the County's property insurance carrier.
