

Resolution No. 20-361

A Resolution of the County of Fresno Board of Supervisors of Intent to Withdraw the County of Fresno from the California Electronic Recording Transaction Network Authority as of July 1, 2021

Whereas, on July 22, 2008, the County of Fresno ("County") executed "ADDENDUM NUMBER 2 TO CERTNA JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT," which is identified by County agreement number 08-397, by which, upon approval on July 24, 2008, by the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the California Electronic Recording Transaction Network Authority, the County became a party to the "Joint Powers Agreement between the Counties of Kern and San Bernardino Creating the California Electronic Recording Transaction Network Authority" ("Agreement"); and

Whereas, Section 11 of the Agreement provides that a party may withdraw from the Agreement as of the first day of July of any year following six months' notice to the other parties by resolution of intent to withdraw adopted by the legislative body of the party; and

Whereas, the County wishes to withdraw from the Agreement as of July 1, 2021;

The Board of Supervisors hereby resolves as follows:

- 1. The County hereby gives notice of its intent to withdraw from the Agreement as of July 1, 2021.
 - 2. This resolution is effective immediately upon its approval.
