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11	WHEREAS, John Emmett (Applicant) made an application to the Fresno County Planning		
12	Commission (Planning Commission) for adoption of a Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for		
13	Initial Study No. 7556 in relation to Unclassified Conditional Use Permit (CUP) No. 3626 for a solid		
14	waste processing facility consisting of an asphalt and concrete crushing operation that will produce		
15	recycled baserock, and have the subject materials stored onsite until it is delivered offsite; and		
16	WHEREAS, the project will provide service to the people of Sanger, Fresno and construction		
17	operations throughout the Fresno County area on property located at 10452 E. Kings Canyon Road,		
18	on the north side of East Kings Canyon Road approximately 1,980 feet west of its nearest		
19	intersection with North Del Rey Avenue and is approximately 1.57 miles northwest of the nearest city		
20	limits of the City of Sanger (the Site); and		
21	WHEREAS, the Site, is located in the AE-20 (Exclusive Agricultural, 20-acre minimum parcel		
22	size) Zone District; and		
23	WHEREAS, on November 19, 2020, the Planning Commission made a motion to deny CUP		
24	No. 3626; and		
25	WHEREAS, an Appeal was made on the Planning Commission's decision to deny CUP No.		
26	3626 and;		
27	WHEREAS, County Zoning Ordinance Section 873(F) requires that an appeal of the		
28	Planning Commissions decisions be heard by the Board of Supervisors (Board); and		
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1	WHEREAS, Pursuant to County Zoning Ordinance Section 873(F), in order for the Board to		
2	approve CUP No. 3654, the Board must make the following findings:		
3	1.	That the Site for the proposed use is adequate in size and shape to accommodate	
4		said use and all yards, spaces, walls and fences, parking, loading, landscaping and	
5		other features required by this Division to adjust said use with land and uses in the	
6		neighborhood.	
7	2.	That the Site for the proposed use relates to streets and highways adequate in width	
8		and pavement type to carry the quantity and kind of traffic generated by the proposed	
9		use.	
10	3.	That the proposed use will have no adverse impact on abutting property and	
11		surrounding neighborhood or permitted use thereof.	
12	4.	That the proposed development is consistent with the General Plan.	
13	5.	That the conditions stated in the resolution are deemed necessary to protect the	
14		public health, safety, and general welfare; and	
15	5 WHEREAS, after duly giving all required public notices, and an opportunity for the public to		
16	speak and present evidence for and against the proposed solid waste processing facility consisting		
17	of an asphalt and concrete crushing operation that will produce recycled baserock, and have the		
18	B subject materials stored onsite until it is delivered offsite, as described herein, and having complied		
19	with all applicable requirements of the law, including the County Zoning Ordinance, the Board		
20	hereby resolves and takes the following actions, including making the following findings.		
21	NOW, THEREFORE, Section 873(F) of the County Zoning Ordinance requires that the Site		
22	for the proposed use is adequate in size and shape to accommodate said use and all yards, spaces,		
23	walls and fences, parking, loading, landscaping and other features required by this Division, to		
24	adjust said use with land and uses in the neighborhood (Finding 1), and, in light of such requirement		
25	the Board her	eby makes the following findings:	
26	•	The proposed project meets the minimum building setback requirements of the	
27		County of Fresno AE-20 Zone District.	
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1	The proposed project is required by Condition of Approval to apply for and receive		
2	approval of a Site Plan Review application to ensure compliance with County		
3	development standards.		
4	Based on the foregoing facts, which this Board has found, the Applicant has satisfied		
5	Finding 1.		
6	NOW, THEREFORE, Section 873(F) of the County Zoning Ordinance requires that the Site		
7	for the proposed use relates to streets and highways adequate in width and pavement type to carry		
8	the quantity and kind of traffic generated by the proposed use (Finding 2), and, in light of such		
9	requirement, the Board hereby makes the following findings:		
10	Estimated trip generation resulting from the project proposal indicate no adverse		
11	impacts to County-maintained roadways that service the parcel.		
12	Based on the foregoing facts, which this Board has found, the Applicant has satisfied		
13	Finding 2.		
14	NOW, THEREFORE, Section 873(F) of the County Zoning Ordinance requires that the		
15	proposed use will have no adverse impact on abutting property and surrounding neighborhood or		
16	permitted use thereof (Finding 3), and, in light of such requirement, the Board hereby makes the		
17	following findings:		
18	A Greenhouse Gas Emissions analysis was prepared and determined that the		
19	proposed use would have a less than significant impact in relation to greenhouse gas		
20	emissions produced from operation of the proposed use.		
21	An acoustical study was prepared and concluded that the project proposal with		
22	implementation of recommended mitigation measures would comply with the		
23	thresholds of significance established in the Fresno County Noise Ordinance.		
24	Mitigation Measures for air quality will be implemented to reduce dust impacts		
25	resulting from the operation.		
26	Based the foregoing facts, which this Board has found, the Applicant has satisfied		
27	Finding 3.		
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1	NOW, THEREFORE, Section 873(F) of the County Zoning Ordinance requires that the		
2	proposed development is consistent with the General Plan (Finding 4), and, in light of such		
3	requirement, the Board hereby makes the following findings:		
4	The subject application is allowed within Agricultural designated areas subject to a		
5	discretionary permit.		
6	Estimated water usage has been analyzed and determined to have a less than		
7	significant impact on water resources.		
8	Based the foregoing facts, which this Board has found, the Applicant/Appellant has		
9	satisfied Finding 4.		
10	NOW, THEREFORE, Section 873(F) of the County Zoning Ordinance requires that the		
11	conditions stated in the resolution are deemed necessary to protect the public health, safety, and		
12	general welfare (Finding 5), and, in light of such requirement, the Board hereby finds that the		
13	following conditions are deemed necessary to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare:		
14	Development of the Site shall be in accordance with the Site Plans, Floor Plans,		
15	Elevations, and Operational Statement approved by the Board.		
16	A Site Plan Review application shall be submitted to and approved by the Director or		
17	the Public Works and Planning, Development Services, and Capital Projects Division		
18	in accordance with Section 874 of the Fresno County Zoning Ordinance.		
19	Based the foregoing conditions, which this Board has deemed necessary to protect		
20	the public health, safety, and general welfare, the Applicant has satisfied Finding 5.		
21	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED that Unclassified Conditional Use		
22	Permit (CUP) No. 3626 for a solid waste processing facility consisting of an asphalt and concrete		
23	crushing operation that will produce recycled baserock, and have the subject materials stored onsite		
24	until it is delivered offsite, is hereby approved subject to the conditions of approval in the Findings,		
25	above.		
26	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its		
27	adoption by the Board.
