10 the Shaver Lake community 24 hours a day, 365 days each year since; and

11 **WHEREAS**, since becoming Chief in 2013, he has personally responded to more than 1,000
12 emergency calls and to over 70% of the 911 calls received; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Tom has, by personal example and through his managerial skills, instilled the
14 Shaver Lake Volunteer Fire Department with the highest level of professionalism; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Tom retired from the Department on January 15, 2021 and the firefighters of the
16 Department, along with the residents, visitors and friends of the Shaver Lake community hereby
17 sincerely express their thanks and gratitude to him for blessing them with his dedication and
18 commitment to unselfishly serving the Department and the Shaver Lake community.

19 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby
20 recognizes and expresses appreciation of the volunteer services of Chief Tom Warner for his many years
21 of service to the community of Shaver Lake and the County of Fresno.


