In 2015 the County Clerk-Elections Department issued an RFP for signature capture and comparison equipment and service. The resulting agreement was awarded to Election Systems and Software(ES&S) which included the purchase of two Mail Ballot Verifier(MBV) machines as well as license and maintenance for the five-year term of the agreement. In 2020 the Department purchased an additional MBV machine in anticipation of a high number of vote-by-mail ballots in the November 2020 Presidential General Election. Continued license and maintenance/support services are required for this equipment.
