SUBJECT: Adopt Prohibiting Scavenging Ordinance Section 8.24.060

RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

Conduct Second Hearing and Adopt Ordinance Prohibiting Scavenging adding new Section 8.24.060 to Chapter 8.24 Waste Disposal of Title 8 of the Fresno County Ordinance Code and waive further reading of the Ordinance in its entirety

With Board approval, upon the completion of the second hearing, the Ordinance will be in effect for one-year. The reenactment of Ordinance Section 8.24.060 will be re-evaluated at the end of 12 months to identify the usefulness and sustainability of the Ordinance

ALTERNATIVE ACTION(S):

The Board of Supervisors may decline to adopt the Ordinance that allows for the initiation of a one-year pilot program prohibiting scavenging.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no Net County Cost associated with the recommended action. Fig Garden Policing District will assume costs associated with enforcement of the pilot program.

DISCUSSION:

On October 17, 2017, the Board conducted the first hearing and approved the reenactment of the Ordinance

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to allow law enforcement an additional year to identify the effectiveness of the program and the staffing demands for potential implementation in other unincorporated areas of Fresno County.
